NO LEAD SERVICE LINES DETECTED

Onslow Water & Sewer Authority (ONWASA) has completed the initial lead service line inventory required by the State of North Carolina for compliance with the US EPA's Lead and Copper Rule Revisions.

ONWASA is pleased to announce that no lead service lines were detected in our assessment of the White Street Industrial Park System.

ONWASA utilized all applicable sources of information, including:

- Construction permits & existing records which indicate service materials
- County parcel year-built data which indicates non-lead service lines on properties built after January 1, 1986.
- Water system records, including distribution system maps, historical records on each service connection and meter installation records
- Inspection & records of the distribution system conducted during normal operations including repairs and maintenance
- Inspections specific to the inventory of the lead and copper survey

In addition to the above methods, ONWASA inspected over 22 customer service connections and verified that they contained no lead at the inspection points. The vast majority of the services had materials consisting of copper, PVC, PEX, and Polyethylene (PE). No lead or galvanized requiring replacement service lines were identified. The subset of service lines that were inspected seem like a reliable indicator that the remaining service lines may be assumed non-lead with a high level of confidence.
